
#### Data analysis:

Analysis: The majority of the teachers rated this aspect as "Good" or "Very Good."


This suggests that the curriculum is somewhat aligned with the institution's vision and mission, but there is room for improvement to achieve an "Excellent" rating.

Mean Score: 3.0Percentage: 60%


Analysis: The feedback indicates a mixed response, with many teachers finding the resource utilization satisfactory. There is a need for better utilization of available resources to improve this score.

Percentage: 80%



Mean Score: 3.7Percentage: 74%


 Analysis: Similar to institutional uniqueness, this aspect received high ratings, indicating that the curriculum adequately considers different student categories and their needs.

Analysis: This aspect was highly rated, reflecting that the curriculum offers appropriate choices tailored to student capabilities.




#### 6. Achievement of Teacher Attributes

o Percentage: 66%


 Analysis: The feedback was less favorable here, indicating a need to enhance the focus on developing teacher attributes.

Analysis: The ratings were varied, suggesting that the development of capability to manage diverse students could be improved.




#### 8. Coping with Contemporary Global Scenario of Teacher Education

o Percentage: 60%


 Analysis: The feedback suggests that there are challenges in aligning the curriculum with global trends in teacher education.

Mean Score: 4.0Percentage: 80%


 Analysis: This aspect was rated highly, indicating that the curriculum is effective in developing planning and management skills.

o **Mean Score:** 4.4


- o Percentage: 89%
